Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 48:1 Handlebars on Motorcycles. Amend RSA 266:77 to read as follows:
2 266:77 [Grips;] Handlebars. ~~[No person shall drive on a way a motorcycle on which the grips~~
3 ~~are higher than the shoulder level of the driver when in the seat or saddle.]~~ It shall be illegal to
4 drive a motorcycle with improvised, defective, or repaired handlebars.
