

Amendment to HB 154

1 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

3 1 Interference With Traffic Devices; Exemptions. Amend the introductory paragraph of
4 RSA 265:15, II(c) to read as follows:

5 (c) This paragraph shall not apply to ***the following persons, who shall be permitted***
6 ***to use traffic signal preemption technology for emergency response purposes:***

7 2 New Paragraph; Interference With Traffic Devices; Fixed-Route Public Transportation Buses.
8 Amend RSA 165:15, II by inserting after subparagraph (d) the following new subparagraph:

9 (e) This paragraph shall not apply to personnel operating fixed-route public
10 transportation buses while in regularly-scheduled service, who shall be permitted to use traffic
11 signal prioritization technology for congestion management purposes.

12 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2018.
