

Amendment to HB 595-FN

1 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

3 1 Secretary of State's Office; Corporations Division; Classified Positions Abolished. The
4 following vacant, classified positions in the corporations division of the secretary of state's office are
5 hereby abolished at the close of business on June 30, 2017:

6 I. Records control clerk (11362), at labor grade 10.

7 II. Records control clerk (18096), at labor grade 10.

8 III. Records control clerk (43452), at labor grade 10.

9 IV. Records control clerk (43456), at labor grade 10.

10 V. Records control clerk (11364), at labor grade 10.

11 VI. Reproducing equip op (40043), at labor grade 8.

12 VII. Clerk II (43460), at labor grade 5.

13 2 Secretary of State's Office; Corporations Division; Classified Positions Established. The
14 following classified positions are hereby established in the corporations division of the secretary of
15 state's office:

16 I. Program specialist I, at labor grade 19.

17 II. Program specialist I, at labor grade 19.

18 III. Program assistant II, at labor grade 15.

19 IV. Data processing supervisor I, at labor grade 15.

20 V. Data librarian I, at labor grade 14, for archives.

21 3 The governor is authorized to draw a warrant for said sum out of any money in the treasury
22 not otherwise appropriated for the data librarian I position referenced in paragraph V of section 2.

23 4 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
