Amendment to SB 129

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

2

3 AN ACT requiring a portion of the renewable energy fund to benefit low to moderate income
4 residential customers, relative to electric renewable energy classes, relative to the
5 class rate for biomass, and relative to requirements for incentive payments from the
6 renewable energy fund.

8 Amend the bill by inserting after section 9 the following and renumbering the original section 10 to
9 read as 11, respectively:

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11 10 Renewable Energy Fund; Incentive Payments. Amend RSA 362-F:10, V to read as follows:

12 V. The public utilities commission shall make and administer a one-time incentive payment
13 of \$3 per watt of nominal generation capacity up to a maximum payment of \$6,000, or 50 percent of
14 system costs, whichever is less, per facility to any residential owner of a small renewable generation
15 facility, that would qualify as a Class I or Class II source of electricity, ~~[has a total peak generation~~
16 ~~capacity of 10 kilowatts or fewer,]~~ begins operation on or after July 1, 2008, and is located on or at
17 the owner's residence.

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill:

- I. Requires a portion of the funds in the renewable energy fund to benefit low-moderate income residential customers.
- II. Makes changes to renewable energy classes.
- III. Raises the class rate for biomass.
- IV. Eliminates the generation capacity requirement for incentive payments from the renewable energy fund.
