

Amendment to SB 144-FN

1 Amend the bill by replacing all after section 1 with the following:

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3 2 Registry Identification Cards. Amend RSA 126-X:4, I(h) to read as follows:

4 (h) A statement signed by the applicant, ***acknowledging that the applicant has***
5 ***received and read the statement explaining federal law as described in RSA 126-X:4, VI,***
6 pledging not to divert cannabis to anyone who is not allowed to possess cannabis pursuant to this
7 chapter, and acknowledging that his or her diversion of cannabis is punishable as a class B felony
8 and ***may result in*** revocation of his or her registry identification card, in addition to other penalties
9 for the illegal sale of cannabis.

10 3 Registry Identification Cards. Amend RSA 126-X:4, II(f) to read as follows:

11 (f) A signed statement from the applicant agreeing to act as the designated caregiver for
12 the qualifying patient named in the application [~~and~~], ***acknowledging that the applicant has***
13 ***received and read the statement explaining federal law as described in RSA 126-X:4, VI,***
14 pledging not to divert cannabis to anyone who is not allowed to possess cannabis pursuant to this
15 chapter, and acknowledging that the diversion of cannabis is punishable as a class B felony and
16 ***may result in the*** revocation of one's registry identification card, in addition to other penalties for
17 the illegal sale of cannabis.

18 4 Departmental Administration: Registry Identification Cards. Amend RSA 126-X:4, VI to
19 read as follows:

20 VI. The department shall provide each ***applicant and each*** approved qualifying patient
21 and designated caregiver a statement with the registry identification card explaining ***current***
22 federal law on the possession of cannabis [~~and~~], that possession of a state registry identification card
23 does not protect a person from federal criminal penalties, ***and that by using cannabis the***
24 ***qualifying patient may be subject to the denial of rights and privileges by federal agencies***
25 ***including, but not limited to, the loss of rights related to employment such as driving a***
26 ***commercial vehicle, the inability to pass a security clearance, and that the qualifying***
27 ***patient will lose the right to own, possess, or purchase a firearm and/or ammunition. The***
28 ***statement shall be updated based on any relevant changes in federal law.***

29 5 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
