

Amendment to SB 234-FN

1 Amend RSA 318:52-c, I as inserted by section 2 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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3 I. No person shall sell, furnish, or give to any person, under 18 years of age, an instrument  
4 commonly known as a hypodermic syringe, hypodermic needle, or any instrument adapted for the  
5 administration of drugs by injection without the written or oral prescription of a licensed physician,  
6 physician assistant, dentist, veterinarian, podiatrist, or advanced practice registered nurse. Such  
7 prescription shall contain the name and address of the patient, the date of the prescription, the  
8 description of the instrument prescribed, and the number of instruments prescribed.

10 Amend RSA 318-B:43, II(d) and (e) as inserted by section 7 of the bill by replacing them with the  
11 following:

13 (d) Post its address, phone number, program contact information, if appropriate, hours  
14 of operation, and services offered on its Internet website.

15 (e) Register with the department of health and human services and confirm registration  
16 annually on or before November 1 of each subsequent year; provided however, the registration  
17 process shall be limited to notification to the department for data collection purposes only.

18 (f) Report quarterly to the department, which report shall include the following  
19 information regarding the program's activities:

- 20 (1) Number of needles/syringes distributed.  
21 (2) Number of needles/syringes taken back.  
22 (3) Number of HIV tests performed or delivered by the program.  
23 (4) Number of HCV tests performed/delivered by program.  
24 (5) Delivery of substance misuse treatment/care.  
25 (6) Delivery of HIV care.  
26 (7) Delivery of HCV care.  
27 (8) Number of referrals to substance misuse treatment/services.  
28 (9) Number of referrals to HIV testing.  
29 (10) Number of referral to HCV testing.  
30 (11) Number of referrals to HIV care.  
31 (12) Number of referrals to HCV care.
