4 That the House recede from its position of nonconcurrence with the Senate amendment, and  
5 concur with the Senate amendment, and

6 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as amended by the  
7 Senate, and pass the bill as so amended:

9 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

11 1 New Section; Retention of Voter Registration Forms. Amend RSA 654 by inserting after  
12 section 13 the following new section:

13 654:13-a Retention of Voter Registration Forms. All voter registration forms and other records  
14 relating to voter registration shall be retained securely in a municipal office under the direction of  
15 the town or city clerk. Those forms and records shall be readily accessible to the supervisors of the  
16 checklist. Any voter registration document submitted at a meeting of the supervisors of the  
17 checklist or at the polling place shall be filed at the office of the town or city clerk within 10 days of  
18 the meeting or election at which it was submitted.

19 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

**AMENDED ANALYSIS**

This bill requires that voter registration forms and other records relating to voter registration be retained securely in a municipal office under the direction of the town or city clerk.
