5 That the Senate recede from its position of nonconcurrence with the House amendment, and

6 That the House recede from its position in adopting its amendment to the bill, and

7 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as amended by the  
8 Senate, and pass the bill as so amended:

10 Amend RSA 237:51 as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

12 237:51 All Electronic Tolling. The department may consider, and if financially feasible, install,  
13 and implement all electronic tolling for toll collection purposes at the existing or future Dover  
14 and/or Rochester tolling facilities along the Spaulding Turnpike upon approval of the governor and  
15 general court.
