

1 Committee of Conference Report on HB 215, establishing a commission to study the legalization,
2 regulation, and taxation of marijuana.

3
4 Recommendation:

5 That the House recede from its position of nonconcurrence with the Senate amendment, and
6 concur with the Senate amendment, and

7 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as amended by the
8 Senate, and pass the bill as so amended:

10 Amend RSA 318-B:43, I as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

11
12 I. There is established a commission to study the legalization, regulation, and taxation of
13 marijuana. The members of the commission shall be as follows:

14 (a) Four members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house
15 of representatives.

16 (b) Two members of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

17 (c) The attorney general, or designee.

18 (d) The commissioner of the department of safety, or designee.

19 (e) The commissioner of the department of health and human services, or designee.

20 (f) The commissioner of the department of revenue administration, or designee.

21 (g) The commissioner of the department of agriculture, markets, and food, or designee.

22 (h) The banking commissioner, or designee.

23 (i) A representative of the New Hampshire Bar Association, appointed by the
24 association.

25 (j) A representative of the New Hampshire Association of Chiefs of Police, appointed by
26 that organization.

27 (k) A representative of the New Hampshire Medical Society, appointed by that
28 organization.

29 (l) A representative of New Futures, appointed by that organization.

30 (m) A representative of the public, appointed by the governor.
