

Committee of Conference Report on SB 155, relative to implementation of the Medicaid managed care program.

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2 Recommendation:

3 That the Senate recede from its position of nonconcurrency with the House amendment, and
4 concur with the House amendment, and

5 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as amended by the
6 House, and pass the bill as so amended:

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8 Amend the bill by replacing section 1 with the following:

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10 1 Medicaid Managed Care Program; Implementation.

11 I. Pending a review of the New Hampshire partnership for long-term care plan by the New
12 Hampshire Association of Counties, in consultation with the county-state finance commission, to
13 conclude no later than July 1, 2018, and notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
14 2 of the remaining unimplemented phases of the Medicaid managed care program, established in
15 RSA 126-A:5, XIX, specifically nursing facility services and services provided under the choices for
16 independence waiver, issued by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) under 42
17 U.S.C. section 1396n(c), shall be incorporated into the Medicaid managed care delivery system
18 beginning on July 1, 2019. The remaining provisions of step 2 of the Medicaid managed care
19 program including services provided under the developmental disability waiver shall not be
20 implemented before July 1, 2019.

21 II. The commissioner shall re-procure contracts with vendors to administer the Medicaid
22 managed care program, with a program start date of July 1, 2019.
