This bill requires a quorum to be present at the deliberative session of the annual meeting in order to amend a petitioned warrant article in towns that have adopted the official ballot referenda form of meeting.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Subparagraph; Official Ballot Referenda; Amendment of Petitioned Warrant Articles.
 2 Amend RSA 40:13, IV by inserting after subparagraph (c) the following new subparagraph:
 3 (d) A quorum must be present to amend a petitioned warrant article. For purposes of
 4 this paragraph, a quorum means 50 percent or more of the number of voters who cast ballots during
 5 the second session of the previous annual meeting.
- 6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
