AN ACT relative to charitable gambling dates.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 Charitable Organizations; Game Dates. Amend RSA 287-D:6, IV to read as follows:

2 IV. Only one license shall be issued to each applicant in any 12 month period to operate

3 games of chance for 10 days, except for charitable organizations registered in the same

4 municipality of the game operator who may operate games of chance for 15 days, which 10

5 or 15 days need not be consecutive.

6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
