Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Consumer Protection; Exempt Transactions. RSA 358-A:3, I is repealed and reenacted to 2 read as follows: 3 I. Trade or commerce that is: 4 (a) Permitted by laws, regulations, standards, orders, or other action of a federal or 5 state regulatory authority that expressly regulate unfair or deceptive acts or practices in the 6 conduct of such transactions. 7 (b) Subject to remedial action by such federal or state regulatory authority through the 8 imposition of damages, restitution, or other monetary recovery for individual consumers injured by 9 an entity's noncompliance with such laws, regulations, standards, orders, or other action of such 10 federal or state regulatory authority.
 - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
