# STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Nineteen

AN ACT relative to certain terminology in the rulemaking authority of the department of education.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

19	(e) Establishment and enforcement of a code of ethics and a code of conduct for
20	[certified] <i>licensed or certified</i> educational personnel as provided in RSA 21-N:9, II(cc).
	258:3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
