Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 70:1 Foster Home Licensing; Compliance with State Fire Code. Amend RSA 170-E:28, II to read 2 as follows:
- 3 II. Either the state fire marshal or the local fire department shall review compliance of the
- 4 foster family home with [applicable state fire safety laws and local ordinances] the state fire code.
- 5 In conducting the review, the state fire marshal or local fire department shall apply the appropriate
- 6 single family or multi-unit dwelling provisions of the [applicable] state fire code. A foster family
- 7 home shall be exempt from local fire regulations and ordinances, provided that the home
- 8 complies with the requirements of the state fire code.
