ANALYSIS

This bill proclaims May 13, 2021 as youth franchise and youth officeholder day in New Hampshire, in honor of the 50th anniversary of New Hampshire's ratification, on May 13, 1971, of the 26th Amendment to the United States Constitution which granted the right to vote to 18-21 year olds and made 18-21 year olds eligible to hold office in the state.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:
