AN ACT relative to review by the insurance department of coverage for pediatric

autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders.

ANALYSIS

This bill requires the commissioner of insurance to review the implementation of the requirement for coverage of pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders as adopted by 2019, 277 (SB 244-FN) and to report to the legislature.

AN ACT relative to review by the insurance department of coverage for pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 Certain Biologically-based Mental Illnesses; Pediatric Autoimmune Insurance; 2 Neuropsychiatric Disorders; Review and Report. The commissioner of the insurance department 3 shall review the implementation of the requirement in RSA 417-E:1, II as amended by 2018, 277 to 4 provide insurance coverage for pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders, when treatment, including the use of intravenous immunoglobulin therapy, is ordered by a physician. Following such 5 6 review, the commissioner shall issue a report, not later than November 1, 2021, to the chairpersons 7 of the house and senate standing committees with jurisdiction over insurance matters.
 - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

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
