Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

3	270:134 Wachipauka Pond (Meader Pond). No person shall operate any boat equipped with a
4	petroleum-powered motor upon the waters of Wachipauka Pond in the town of Warren. An electric
5	power motor rated no more than 55 pounds may used on Wachipauka Pond, provided one of the
3	operators is a holder of a walking disability plate issued by the department of motor vehicles under
7	RSA 261:88. Whoever violates this section shall be guilty of a violation.
