

Amendment to HB 260-FN

1 Amend RSA 261:75, II as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 II. Every vehicle driven in or on any way in this state, if required to be registered hereunder,
4 shall have displayed conspicuously thereon a number plate or plates to be furnished by the
5 department, together with any current validation sticker issued by the department and which has a
6 changeable designation of their effective period. The director may make special rules relative to the
7 number of plates, the location of said plate or plates on the vehicle, and the material and design
8 thereof, provided, however, that number plates for passenger vehicles shall have the state motto
9 "Live Free or Die" written thereon, ***and further provided that an antique vehicle, as defined in***
10 ***RSA 259:4, a custom vehicle, as defined in RSA 259:17-a, or a street rod, as defined in RSA***
11 ***259:106-a, shall only be required to display one number plate on the rear of the vehicle.*** The
12 plate shall be kept clean.
