

1 Committee of Conference Report on HB 25-A, making appropriations for capital improvements.

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3 Recommendation:

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5 That the House recede from its position of nonconcurrency with the Senate amendment, and
6 concur with the Senate amendment, and

7 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as amended by the
8 Senate, and pass the bill as so amended:

10 Amend section 1 of the bill by replacing paragraph I with the following:

11 *The funds appropriated to the department of administrative services in subparagraph 14 for the
12 Rochester Circuit Court replacement engineering shall not be spent, obligated, or encumbered until
13 such time as a suitable site for the courthouse has been approved by the capital budget overview
14 committee. The general court intends that funding to complete the Rochester circuit court project
15 will be included in the state capital budget for the biennium ending June 30, 2025.

17 Amend section 1 of the bill by replacing paragraph VIII with the following:

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19 VIII. Judicial Branch

20	1. NH e-Court	1,100,000
21	2. Courts Digitization Project *	50,000
22	Total state appropriation paragraph VIII	\$1,150,000

23 * The general court intends that funding to complete the Supreme Court digitization project will
24 be included in the state capital budget for the biennium ending June 30, 2025.

26 Amend the bill by replacing section 10 with the following:

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28 10 Department of Administrative Services; Inspection Services; Davis-Bacon Compliance; ARPA
29 Funds Reports.

30 I. The appropriations for those projects which are managed by the division of public works
31 design and construction, department of administrative services, may be expended to fund temporary
32 personnel for the purpose of providing construction inspection services and Davis-Bacon Act
33 compliance services for projects utilizing federal funds, for those projects included in this act.

34 II. The department of administrative services shall provide quarterly reports to the capital
35 budget overview committee detailing the project status for all capital projects, including information
36 technology projects, funded by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) that have been
37 approved by the fiscal committee of the general court. The first quarterly report shall be for the

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1 quarter ending December 31, 2021.
