Dear Madam Clerk,

Earlier this year, I filed Declaration of Intent forms for a few bills, not realizing that by filing the forms I was considered by the Legislative Ethics Committee to be declaring a conflict of interest on the particular bills. My purpose in filing the forms was, in the interest of transparency, to call attention to connections I might have had with parties interested in the legislation, but nothing that rose to the level of a conflict of interest. That had appeared to be one way the Declaration of Intent form had been used by others in the past, and I simply followed that example.

Now that I have been apprised of the fact that the filing of a Declaration of Intent Form signifies to the Legislative Ethics Committee that a conflict of interest exists, or may exist, I hereby rescind my Declaration of Intent on the following bills, as there is no conflict of interest:

HB 186
SB 365
SB 302

Please note that there are other Declaration of Intent forms I filed on other bills, where I stated I would not participate. These particular bills did create a conflict of interest, or may have, thus, I did not participate in any legislative activities related to them.
