3 336 Chartered Public Schools; Funding. Amend RSA 194-B:11, I(b)(1) to read as follows:

4 (b)(1) Except as provided in subparagraph (2), for a chartered public school authorized
5 by the state board of education pursuant to RSA 194-B:3-a, the state shall pay tuition pursuant to
6 RSA 198:40-a plus an additional grant of \$2,000 directly to the chartered public school for each pupil
7 who is a resident of this state in attendance at such chartered public school. *Beginning July 1,*
8 *2015 and every biennium thereafter, the department of education shall adjust the per pupil*
9 *amount of the additional grant based on the average change in the Consumer Price Index*
10 *for All Urban Consumers, Northeast Region, using the "services less medical care services"*
11 *special aggregate index, as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, United States*
12 *Department of Labor.*

13 ___ Effective Date. Section 336 of this act shall take effect July 1, 2015.

Draft Amendment to HB 2-FN-A-LOCAL

1 1 State College and University System; Trustees of the University System. Amend RSA 187-
2 A:13 to read as follows:

3 187-A:13 Trustees of University System. The general government of the university system and
4 its constituent divisions and institutions shall be vested in a single board of 27 trustees composed as
5 follows and in accordance with the following conditions:

6 I. [~~Eight~~] *Ten* ex-officio members: the governor of the state, the chancellor of the university
7 system, the commissioner of agriculture, markets, and food, the commissioner of education, the
8 president of the university of New Hampshire, the president of Plymouth state university, the
9 president of Keene state college, the president of the Granite state college, *the speaker of the*
10 *house of representatives or designee, the president of the senate or designee;*

11 II. [~~Eleven~~] *Eight* members appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the
12 council;

13 III.(a) Two members shall be students enrolled at Keene state college, Plymouth state
14 university, Granite state college, or the university of New Hampshire who shall serve as student
15 trustees, for the term indicated in this paragraph, on a rotating basis in the order listed below:

16 (1) One student each from the university of New Hampshire and Plymouth state
17 university.

18 (2) One student each from Plymouth state university and Granite state college.

19 (3) One student each from Granite state college and Keene state college.

20 (4) One student each from Keene state college and the university of New Hampshire.

21 (b) The student trustees shall be elected by the student body at the school responsible for
22 providing the student trustees. The term of the student trustees shall be for one year commencing
23 July 1 of the year for which the student was elected and ending June 30 of the next year. Student
24 trustees shall be expected to serve the full duration of their elected term. In the event that a student
25 trustee ceases for any reason to attend the school from which the student was elected, the chancellor
26 of the university system shall declare a vacancy in that student trustee position, and the school
27 causing the vacancy shall elect a replacement student trustee who shall serve for the remainder of
28 the predecessor's term. Graduation of a student trustee shall not constitute a vacancy under this
29 paragraph.

30 IV. Four members elected by the alumni of the university of New Hampshire;

31 V. One member elected by the alumni of Keene state college;

32 VI. One member elected by the alumni of Plymouth state university[-];

1 *VII. One member elected by the alumni of Granite state college.*

2 At all times, 2 members of the board shall be farmers and both major political parties shall be
3 represented on the board.
