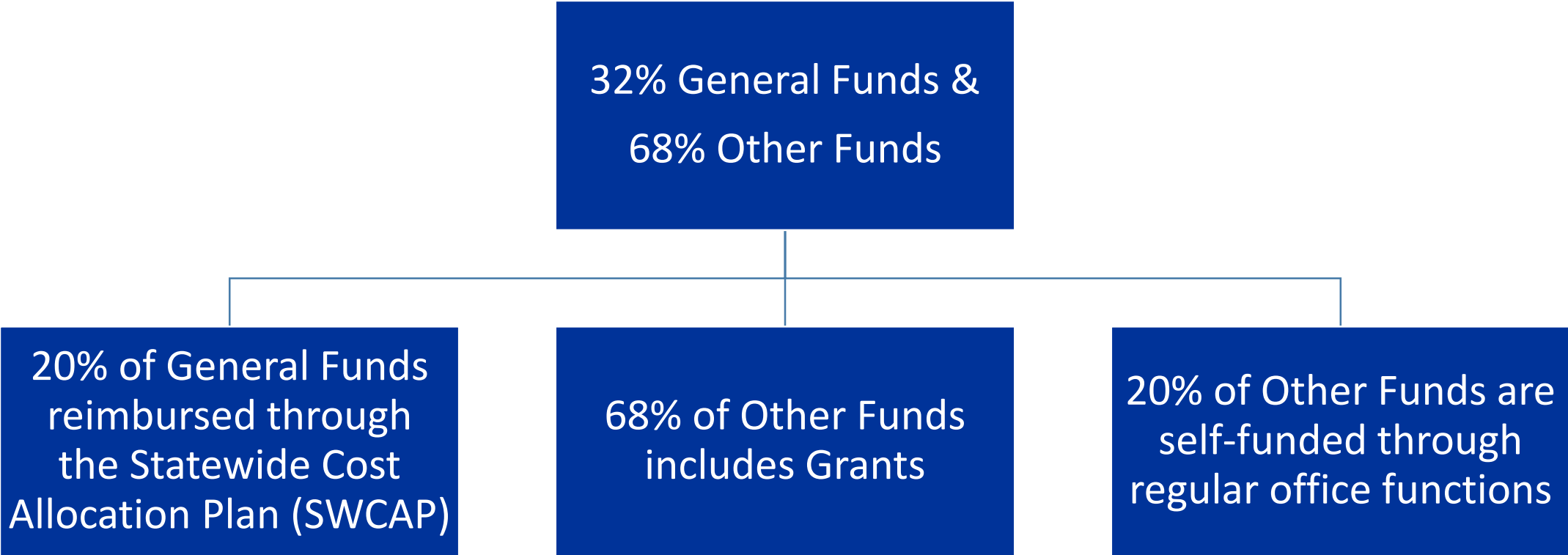

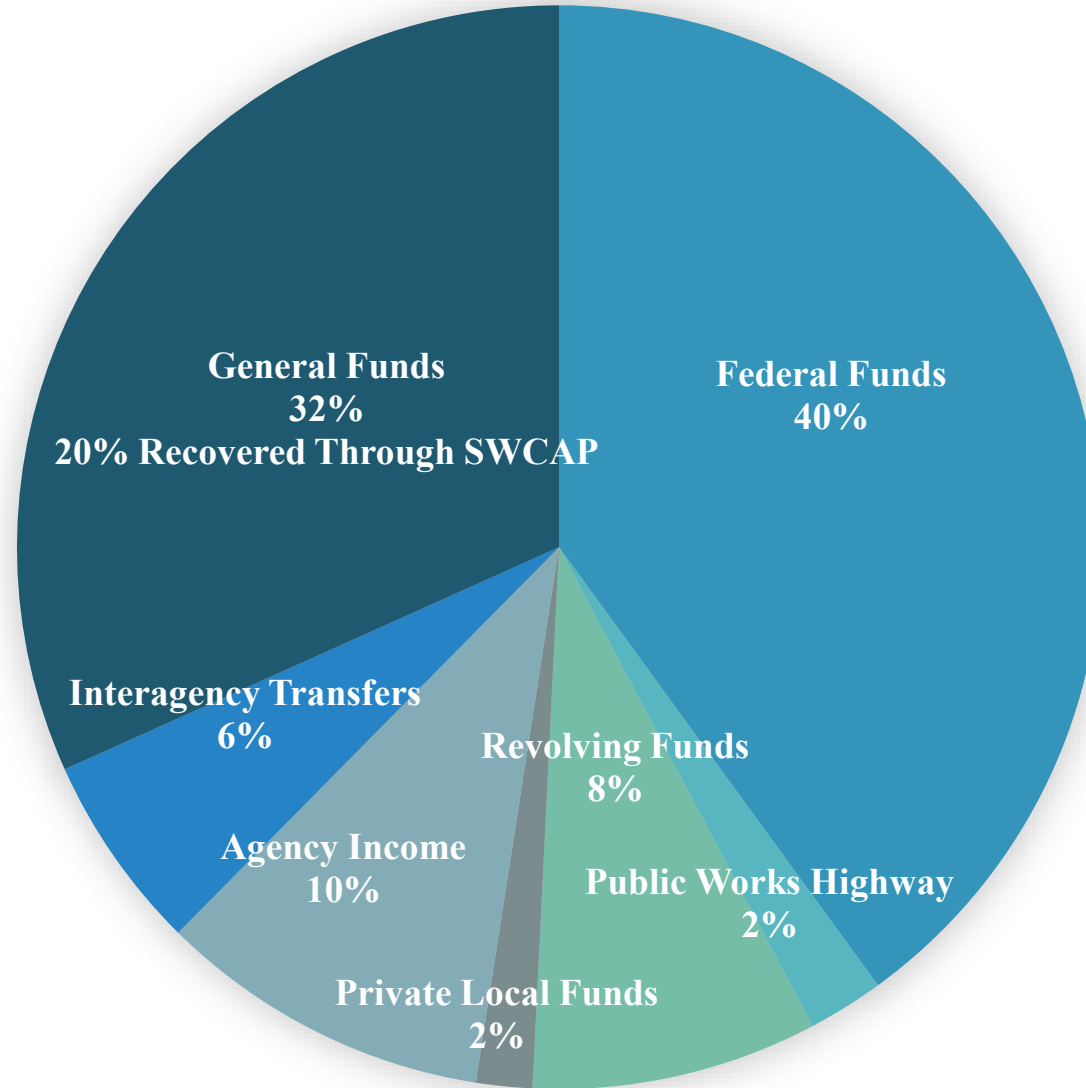
COVID-19 Emergency Response Efforts



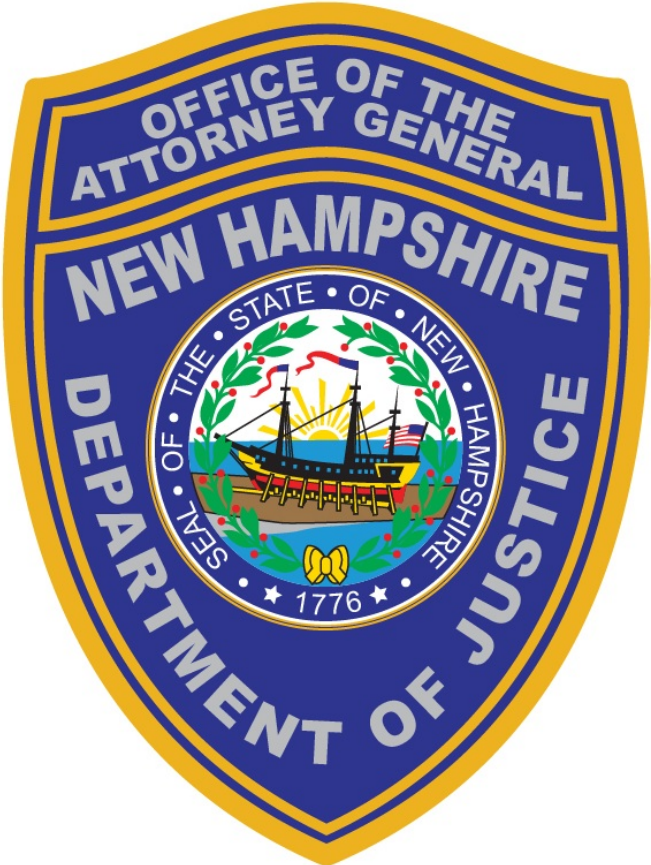
Governor's Budget: Overview
