Governor Sununu Vetoes SB 10, Blocks Long-Overdue Minimum Wage Increase

CONCORD—Today, Governor Sununu vetoed SB 10, Senate President Donna Soucy’s seventh bill to re-establish and raise New Hampshire’s minimum wage. SB 10 would have raised the minimum wage to \$10/hour in 2020 and \$12/hour in 2022.

After the veto, prime sponsor Senator Donna Soucy (D-Manchester) released the following statement:

“While it is disappointing that Governor Sununu vetoed legislation today to re-establish and raise New Hampshire’s minimum wage, I remain committed to this fight and extend my sincere gratitude to the advocates and lawmakers pushing to raise the wage. New Hampshire values work—it’s far past time for us to guarantee that hardworking Granite Staters earn enough to support themselves and their families.”
