- 1 Department of Health and Human Services; Division of Children, Youth and Families (DCYF);
 2 Residential Placement and Treatment of Children.
 - I. The DCYF shall renegotiate with contractors currently providing residential treatment for children in New Hampshire. The contracts shall comply with the requirements and metrics of RSA 135-F and RFP-2021-DBH-12-RESID, including, but not limited to, providing evidence based treatment, minimizing the use of restraint and seclusion and agreeing to treat all referrals made by DCYF.
 - II. The DCYF shall negotiate contracts for residential placement of minors in New Hampshire who are eligible for commitment pursuant to RSA 169-B:19. The contracts shall comply with the requirements and metrics of RSA 135-F, 170-G:4-d, and RFP-2021-DBH-12-RESID, including, but not limited to, providing evidence-based treatment, minimizing the use of restraint and seclusion, the use of outcome measurement, and the use of uniform assessment instruments.
 - III. The DCYF may negotiate increased rates, changes in staffing ratios and additional security to accommodate children who present more complex behavioral health needs. DCYF shall determine the number of beds to be charged at the increased rate, but the number shall not exceed 20 beds among all contractors. Further, the contractors shall make all reasonable efforts to ensure the programs continues to provide services consistent with CMS requirements for Medicaid reimbursement. The contractors shall begin taking admissions not later than April 1, 2022 but may accept admissions earlier.
 - IV. The amended contracts under this section shall be presented to the governor and executive council for approval not later than December 1, 2021.
