LRCP 24-006 Department of Health and Human Services – request approval of a ten-year lease with Northamptonboys3, LLC, 143A Main Street, North Hampton, Massachusetts 01060 for continued occupation of approximately 15,871 square feet of office space located at 109 Key Road, Keene, for the Department's Keene District Office, effective April 1, 2024 with an end date of March 31, 2034 for a total lease cost of \$3,564,000, subject to the conditions as specified in the request dated March 12, 2024
