Chairman Cloutier called the meeting to order at 2:08 p.m.

ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES:

On a motion by Representative Chandler, seconded by Senator Gallus, that the minutes of the September 15, 2009 meeting be accepted as written. MOTION ADOPTED.

AMENDMENT OF MINUTES:

<u>LRCP 09-054 Office of Legislative Budget Assistant</u> – request to amend the minutes of the April 21, 2009 meeting specifically, page two line three of paragraph four, regarding the parcel acreage.

On a motion by Senator D'Allesandro, seconded by Senator Gallus, that the Committee reconsider the approved minutes of the April 21, 2009 meeting. MOTION ADOPTED.

<u>LRCP 09-046 Department of Transportation</u> – William Oldenburg, Administrator, and Phillip Miles, Chief of Property Management, Bureau of Right-of-Way, Department of Transportation presented the request and responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative Chandler, seconded by Senator D'Allesandro, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Transportation, Bureau of Right-of-Way, to enter into a listing agreement with H.G. Johnson Real Estate, for a term of one (1) year at a 6% commission, to sell a 4.5 +/- acre parcel of State owned land located on the easterly side of NH Route 106 and the northerly side of Staniels Road, as now traveled, in the Town of Loudon for \$225,000, plus assess an Administrative Fee of \$1,100, and subject to the conditions as specified by the Department in the request dated October 2, 2009. MOTION ADOPTED.

<u>LRCP 09-047 Department of Transportation</u> – William Oldenburg, Administrator, Bureau of Right-of-Way, Department of Transportation requested to withdraw the request for approval to enter into a listing agreement with Coldwell Banker Residential Broker, for a term of one (1) year at a 6% commission, to sell a 0.6 acre parcel of State owned land located on the westerly side of Smyth Road, southerly of Interstate 93, in the City of Manchester for \$65,000 and assess an Administrative Fee of \$1,100, as specified by the Department in the request dated October 1, 2009. RSA 4:40 DISPOSAL OF REAL ESTATE AND RSA 228:67 DISPOSITION OF ACQUIRED OR ABANDONED RAIL PROPERTIES:

<u>LRCP 09-048 Department of Transportation</u> – Louis Barker, Railroad Planner, Bureau of Rail and Transit, Department of Transportation presented the request and responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative Chandler, seconded by Senator D'Allesandro, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Transportation, Bureau of Rail and Transit, to lease 3,528 square feet of the State-owned Concord to Lincoln Railroad corridor in Belmont for a proposed lease fee of \$1,300 per year for five years, with a five-year renewal provision and assess an Administrative Fee of \$1,100, to Richard and Carol Morway, as specified by the Department in the request dated September 14, 2009, with clarification by the Department that construction and maintenance of a fence to prevent access onto the railroad track will be done by Richard and Carol Morway. MOTION ADOPTED.

<u>LRCP 09-049 Office of The Adjutant General</u> – Brigadier General Stephen Burritt, Deputy Adjutant General, presented the request and responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative Chandler, seconded by Senator D'Allesandro, that the Committee approve the request from the Office of the Adjutant General to grant a utility easement twenty (20) feet wide on the easterly side of Airport Road in Concord to Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. and New England Telephone Operations, LLC for no cost and authorization to waive the Administrative Fee, as specified in the request dated October 6, 2009. MOTION ADOPTED.
