The Chair called the meeting to order at 9:31 a.m.

ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES:

On a motion by Senator D'Allesandro, seconded by Representative McConkey, that the minutes of the September 13, 2021 meeting be accepted as written. MOTION ADOTPED. (6-Yes; 1-Abstained)

OLD BUSINESS:

LRCP 21-031 Additional Information Department of Transportation, dated October 25, 2021 pertaining to LRCP 21-031 Department of Transportation – requests approval to dispose of two (2) parcels of state-owned land located on Skimobile Road in the town of Conway by entering into a listing agreement for a term of one (1) year with Badger Realty, listing 2.94 +/-acres of vacant land (Parcel A) for \$750,000, and 0.49 +/- of an acre, with improvements, (Parcel B) for \$311,000, assessing an Administrative Fee of \$1,100 for each parcel, and allowing negotiations within the Committees current policy guidelines, subject to the conditions as specified in the request dated August 23, 2021. **Tabled 09/13/2021**

On a motion by Senator Birdsell, seconded by Representative Cloutier, that the Committee <u>amend</u> the request of the Department of Transportation to dispose of two (2) parcels of state-owned land located on Skimobile Road in the town of Conway by entering into a listing agreement for a term of one (1) year with Badger Realty, listing 2.94 +/- acres of vacant land (Parcel A) for <u>\$825,000</u>, not \$750,000, and 0.49 +/- of an acre, with improvements, (Parcel B) for <u>\$335,000</u>, not <u>\$311,000</u>, assessing an Administrative Fee of \$1,100 for each parcel, and allowing negotiations within the Committees current policy guidelines, subject to the conditions as specified in the request dated August 23, 2021, tabled 09/13/2021. MOTION ADOPTED.

On a motion by Senator D'Allesandro, seconded by Senator Birdsell, that the Committee **approve as amended** the request of the Department of Transportation to dispose of two (2) parcels of state-owned land located on Skimobile Road in the town of Conway by entering into a listing agreement for a term of one (1) year with Badger Realty, listing 2.94 +/- acres of vacant land (Parcel A) for \$825,000, not \$750,000, and 0.49 +/- of an acre, with improvements, (Parcel B) for \$335,000, not \$311,000, assessing an Administrative Fee of \$1,100 for each parcel, and allowing negotiations within the Committees current policy guidelines, subject to the conditions as specified in the request dated August 23, 2021, tabled 09/13/2021. MOTION ADOPTED.

RSA 4:39-c DISPOSAL OF HIGHWAY OR TURNPIKE FUNDED REAL ESTATE:

<u>LRCP 21-034 Department of Transportation</u> – Stephen LaBonte, Administrator, Bureau of Right-of-Way, Department of Transportation responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative Cloutier, seconded by Senator Birdsell, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Transportation to sell two (2) parcels of state-owned land totaling approximately 5.2 +/- acres located on the westerly side of NH Route 16 (Spaulding Turnpike) in the Town of Newington directly to the S.N.S. Equity LLC for the amount of \$1,111,200, which includes an \$1,100 Administrative Fee per parcel, subject to the conditions as specified in the request dated October 18, 2021. MOTION ADOPTED. (6-Yes; 1-No)

<u>LRCP 21-035 Department of Transportation</u> – Stephen LaBonte, Administrator, Bureau of Right-of-Way, Department of Transportation responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Senator D'Allesandro, seconded by Senator Birdsell, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Transportation to dispose of a 2.73 +/- acre parcel of state-owned land, with improvements, located at 86 Remoat Trail (formerly Kearsarge Road) in the Town of Conway, by entering into a listing agreement for a term of one year with Coldwell Banker Lifestyles at a listing price of \$300,000, and pursuant to RSA 4:40, III-A, assessing an Administrative Fee of \$1,100, and allowing negotiations within the Committees current policy guidelines, subject to the conditions as specified in the request dated October 19, 2021. MOTION ADOPTED.
