In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty One

AN ACT relative to the authority of schools to display the national and state mottos.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 161:1 New Section; State and National Mottos. Amend RSA 189 by inserting after section 17-a

 3 189:17-b Authority of Schools to Display the National and State Mottos. Notwithstanding any
 4 other provision of law to the contrary, no power or authority of the state of New Hampshire, or any
 5 political subdivision thereof, shall in any way restrict, or be construed to restrict, the authority of
 6 any school or school district to display the national motto, "In God We Trust," or the state motto,
 7 "Live Free or Die," in any school building.
