Amend RSA 426-A by inserting after section 6 the 7 following new section: 8 426-A:7 Produce; Stop Sale. When the commissioner or the commissioner's authorized agent 9 has reasonable cause to believe produce is being distributed in violation of any of the provisions of 10 this chapter, or of any of the rules adopted under this chapter, the commissioner or agent may issue and serve a written "stop sale, use or removal" order upon the owner or custodian of any such 11 12 produce. The produce shall not be sold, used or removed until the provisions of this chapter have 13 been complied with and the produce has been released by the commissioner or the violation has been
