Any local legislative body may establish a planning board[, the members of which shall be 4 residents of the municipality]. $\mathbf{5}$ 2 New Paragraph; Establishment of Local Land Use Boards; Membership. Amend RSA 673:1 by inserting after paragraph V the following new paragraph: $\mathbf{6}$ $\overline{7}$ VI. Voting members of any local land use board established pursuant to paragraphs I-V, 8 including ex officio members, shall be residents of the municipality in which they serve. 9 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
