## In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty One

AN ACT establishing a commission to study ways to reduce texting while driving.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

10	(c) The commissioner to the department of transportation, or designee.
11	(d) The president of the Cellular Telecommunications and Internet Association, or
12	designee.
13	(e) The commissioner of the department of safety, or designee.
14	(f) One member of the public, appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.
15	III. Legislative members of the commission shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when
16	attending to the duties of the commission.
17	IV. The commission shall study ways to reduce texting while driving.
18	V. The members of the commission shall elect a chairperson from among the members. The
19	first meeting of the commission shall be called by the first-named house member. The first meeting
20	of the commission shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this section. Five members of
21	the commission shall constitute a quorum.
22	VI. The commission shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
23	legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house
24	clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2021.
25	110:2 Repeal. RSA 265:162, relative to the commission to study ways to reduce texting while
26	driving, is repealed.
