SENATE BILL

556-FN

AN ACT prohibiting health carriers from establishing payment or reimbursement provisions based solely on a participating provider's licensure.

This bill prohibits health carriers from establishing payment or reimbursement provisions based solely on a participating provider's licensure.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 New Subparagraph; Managed Care Law; Provider Contract Standards. Amend RSA 420-J:8,
- 2 VIII by inserting after subparagraph (e) the following new subparagraph:
- 3 (f) A health carrier shall not establish payment or reimbursement provisions based
- 4 solely on a participating provider's licensure.
- 5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2025.
