Statement by Senate President Chuck Morse on the release of New Hampshire's September state revenues

Concord, NH – Senate President Chuck Morse (R-Salem) issued the following statement today on the release of <u>September state revenues</u>, which reflect the continued three-month trend of climbing state surpluses:

"Responsible budgeting by New Hampshire Republicans has spurred consistent economic prosperity for the Granite State, with September alone exceeding revenue expectations by \$50 million," stated Senator Morse.

"Through the first three months of the Fiscal Year, state revenues exceeded projections by \$89.2 million thanks to conservative economic strategies. This financial success has allowed the Legislature to deliver \$500 million in property tax relief and \$42 million in emergency fuel and energy assistance for families struggling with home heating costs. New Hampshire Republican's fiscal responsibility is giving more back to our communities and alleviating economic pressure for Granite Staters when they need it most."
