Survey Review	<p>Many members of the Council provided feedback that the grade level/accessibility/literacy level seems too high in the survey and requested that be adjusted prior to distribution. Further, around language, the general survey will be distributed in English to the Granite State Panel. More discussion to be had about translating into other languages for targeted community information gathering. Ann Landry offered to set up a separate meeting, if needed, regarding language access.</p> <p>Re: question related to availability of health insurance; a request was made to update the word “availability” to access and also to add affordable to the question.</p> <p>Re: housing – remove safe</p> <p>Re: H1 – remove question</p> <p>Re: access to food – add affordable to the question.</p> <p>Re: recreation – a request was made to be more specific around physical activity.</p> <p>Across the board for the survey, requests were made to be mindful of the tense used in questions (for example, H2a. uses past tense and it should be present.</p> <p>Re: H.7., for Yes – what insurance – add branch</p> <p>For social isolation, add family vs. community. Consider cultural isolation.</p> <p>A suggestion was made that the current Stay, Work, Play survey may have similarly worded questions and responses already collected.</p>

Senator Sherman appointed Dr. Ramas as the subcommittee chair.
